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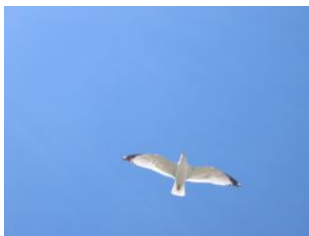


Figure 1: Example: seagull. Note that all the figures, even in color, are printed in black-and-white.
